This year 625 high school students were tested in College Station, Cedar Park, and Dallas. This number was nearly double that of last year! Rexcites Floral Designers!


April 19th was a night for the ages! Southern Floral Co. in Austin hosted this glorious occasion — as a fund raiser for the Texas Floral Endowment scholarship program. They provided hors d'oeuvres, party foods and wine for the attendees. Great bargains on hot merchandise made shopping fun and the camaraderie among florist friends made the atmosphere electric! The great Southern crew transformed the wholesale area into an impressive stage and presentation area.

The florists — owners and employees alike sat enraptured by Hitomi as she created design inspiration for each one. Handtied bouquets, floral jewelry and arrangements for the home were put together before our very eyes. Hitomi stressed the use of armatures as a trendy way to "capture time." By that she meant once an armature is made, which could be done way ahead of time, it can take only a few minutes to add the flowers later. If it is a rental item, then the labor already spent on it doesn't have to be repeated on its next use.

The presentation began with a showing of hand-tied bouquets made by Hitomi and 3 friends and former students, who drove in from Dallas to help. Cecelia Manouel, Aki Ishiguro, and Kiyomi Kurihara each designed unique and amazing bouquets which could be displayed in a vase at home or carried by a bride. Living floral jewelry followed... and again each piece was an armature made with aluminum wire, bead wire and finished with a fresh blossom or two and

trend-setting jewels. Hitomi described the advantages and profitability of each.

These were followed by a great assortment of designs created in both fresh and permanent flowers — some taller than Hitomi herself! A few were minimal with just one or only a few flowers, while others were extravagant...including combinations of both fresh and permanent flowers in the same design. Why not use realistic looking permanent hydrangeas or orchids at the top of a tall centerpiece while using the real thing at the base where people see the detail of a blossom? Save money, eliminate wilt, capture space, increase profits — all the while establishing your reputation as the "go-to" floral artist in your market area.

All of the designs were auctioned off with the profits going into TFE Scholarships. A wonderful benefit for many attendees new to the industry, was that they joined TSFA! These new members all expressed their excitement at being with other florists — getting acquainted, learning, and gaining inspiration — in other words they felt the same benefits that we established members feel! TFE thanks Susan Weatherford & Southern Floral Co. for their huge contribution.
