# Level Two Floral Design Certification



## Certification Options

**Three of the four below must be successfully completed:**

- Attend one hands-on workshop
- Volunteer at one Level 1 testing site
- Volunteer at one community event sharing flowers (nursing homes, etc.) or a regional design show approved by TSFA
- Should re-test with floral design teacher to be able to confirm that student can make a triangle design

**And:**

- Hands-on test of corsage and two designs/tasks directly from the TSFA Principles and Elements of Floral Design Teacher's Edition Curriculum
  - Corsage (p. 49 or p. 52-53)
  - Vase design of mixed/seasonal flowers or Bud Vase (p. 70)
  - Contemporary design with silk botanicals

All of the above requirements will be submitted in a portfolio and signed off by your Floral Design Teacher. This portfolio will then be submitted in it's entirety to the TSFA Education Committee for evaluation. One on One critique/discussion to follow.

## Mandatory Requirements

- Must have obtained the Level 1 Certification
- Must be able to design and submit photos in a portfolio of:
  - Asymmetrical arrangement
  - Vase arrangement/Dozen Carnations in 20 minutes
  - Bow making/Dress a Plant
  - Contemporary permanent botanical arrangement in a cylinder vase or square vase (3"x3" or 3"x4")
