1. Nice Boutonniere

- 2. Floral taping should be tight and smooth
- Rose stem should be trimmed shorter before wiring and taping to create a transition from size of stem to wired stem.
- 4. Rose foliage will not hold up long enough to be used on a boutonniere.
- 5. Foliage is too large for size of rose head. Proportion is important.
- Hole created in receptacle, by pierced wire, will turn dark & rusty within a short period of time, this should be covered completely by floral tape.
- Wire spiraled around stem creates ridges on what should be a fairly smooth floral taped wrapped stem. Hold wire in place while taping.
- When leather leaf foliage added, shave the end of the stem, so as to create less detail when taped.
- Be careful to hold foliage stem in place lengthwise while taping, so does not spiral around floral taped stem.
- 10. Wire at bottom of stem should be totally covered with tape, no sharp edges seen or felt.
- 11. If creating a pig tail curl at the end of the stem (which we do not show in our design information) it should transition from rose stem to wired curl with a smooth and gradual change in size of stem to wire, not ragged transition.
