....and here's how he brought a little "HAPPY" to thousands worldwide

Have you ever wondered as to just how a split second thought leads to an inspired idea? Have you ever had an idea and then looked back to your very first recollection of it and then to all that led you forward to perfect it? We often find that there are situations in our lives that lead to memorable moments and, in our world, these moments are often tied to the beauty of flowers.

Chris Norwood has been on a local TV segment, KATV Good Morning Arkansas, for over 20 years. Once COVID hit, he was not able to go into the studio. "People were calling to ask what was going on, were we okay, why wasn't the segment on flowers being shown? It was those moments that led me to do my first Facebook Live video on March 16, 2020," noted Chris.

On that first day, he shared with the few who joined him, "Let's just make something happy in this sad world right now." He must have done just that because "HAPPY" will celebrate four years next month!



It took a few weeks for "HAPPY" to grow. During the first two weeks, Chris would boost it once a week to the local community so his customers could see pretty flowers. Posting on some flower related Facebook groups was also helpful in the beginning...and then it just took off! Boosting stopped and sharing was minimized. The following was grass roots at its finest, simply turning to word of mouth to pass it on.

When asked as to the inspiration of each episode, Chris commented that "sometimes we preplan what we are doing if we have received new containers, flowers, a thought of a new technique to feature and so on, but quite often, we create the arrangements that are for orders. It may be a design to be delivered or wedding preparations on a Friday — and always a glimpse into the life of an everyday florist. I always say time is money, so if we have an order and it's "happy" time, we can kill two birds with one stone!"

Today, over 88,000 followers tune in from over 50 countries! When asked about the worldwide sensation, Chris happily shares "We stopped counting countries at 50!" Nearly 10,759 followers were viewing when the "HAPPY" videos began. On any ordinary "HAPPY", Chris will visit with 400-700 in LIVE views, and after 24 hours, views are around 15,000-20,000!

Chris and his Tipton & Hurst family are amazed at the number of people who travel from all over the country to visit the store and to view a "HAPPY" video LIVE! "So many of the viewers have become family to us. If we do not see them watching after a few days, we reach out and check on them and vice versa. If we are not on, they call and check on us."

To have started during an unprecedented time and to still be going strong says a great deal about this inspired idea! To be deeply involved in an industry that celebrates life, causing those that are loved to smile and making countless souls happy, speaks volumes about the man behind "HAPPY"!
