GENERAL DESIGN STATEMENTS

Corsage:

- **Corsage must be a crescent design utilizing 6 flowers and 6 foliage elements**
- **Mechanics must be secure and complete for optimal wearing with no exposed wire ends**
- **Completed corsage design must be a salable product**

Asymmetrical Fresh Design:

- **Completed design should be 18" tall and 18" wide**
- **Design will consist of 9 standard carnations, 3 stems of mini-carnations, 10 stem combination of Myrtle, Leather Leaf, and Salal/Lemon Leaf, 1/3 brick of wet foam, 1 green design bowl, and anchor tape**
- **Completed design should have depth when viewed from the sides**
- **Completed design should possess a focal area that is obvious to the observer**
- **Critical elements of design should be present and obvious to the observer**
- **Completed design should be a salable product**

Dozen-Stem Vase Arrangement:

- **Design will be judged on stem placement, not product quality**
- **Design will be: 1 dozen long stem Carnations or 1 dozen long stems Roses (50 cm) in a vase with 10 stems of Leather Leaf and 1/3 bunch of Wax Flower, Heather or Limonium**
- **No extra product will be provided**
- **Vase: Classic Urn 8 3/4" (Syndicate Sales #4036-12-09)**
- **Over all height of finished design: 18" to 20"**
- **Completed arrangement should be approximately: 14" to 16" wide**
- **Grid will be created by a Criss-Cross stem insertion pattern (see diagram in slide #6)**
- **Graders will not count off for broken carnation/ rose stems that have been re-wired and fixed correctly.**
- **Broken stems will not be replaced, but may be wired to fix, if needed**
- **#20 or #21 wire will be available, if needed for this purpose**
- **Graders will not count off for inferior product**
- **Designs will be judged on stem placement**
- **Strict guidelines and procedures will be monitored**
