Level Two Floral Design Certification



Two of the four below must be successfully completed and included in the portfolio:

- Attend one hands-on floral workshop
- · Volunteer at one Level 1 testing site
- Volunteer at one community event sharing flowers (nursing homes, etc.) or a regional design show approved by TSFA
- Test with floral design teacher to be able to confirm that student can make a triangle design

And:

- Hands-on test of corsage and two designs/tasks directly from the TSFA Principles and Elements of Floral Design Teacher's Edition Curriculum
 - Corsage
 - Asymmetrical arrangement
 - · Stylized design with silk botanicals

All of the above requirements will be submitted in a portfolio and signed off by your Floral Design Teacher. This portfolio will then be submitted in it's entirety to the TSFA Education Committee for evaluation.



Mandatory Requirement

- · Must have obtained the Level 1 Certification
- Must be able to design and submit photos in a portfolio with completed designs:
 - · Asymmetrical arrangement
 - Vase arrangement/Dozen Carnations in 20 minutes
 - · Bow making/Dress a Plant
 - Stylized permanent botanical arrangement in a cylinder vase or a square vase (3"-4")

Please submit your portfolio to TSFA in a PDF document prior to hands-on Level 2 testing.
