Endowment (TFE), approved by the IRS as a charitable organization with a 501 (c) 3 rating, is a non-profit corporation established to fund educational opportunities, scholarships and consumer awareness events relevant to floriculture. Incorporated in 1991, all the investments made in the Endowment are tax deductible whether business or personal.


